Late Fees: Boarding fees received fifteen (15) days after the agreed upon date of payment will incur a \$25.00 late fee.

Feed and Facilities:

Worthmore agrees to provide hay and feed to aforementioned horse. Unless agreed upon, the owner, if required, will supply supplements, vitamins and/or specialized feeds. Horse will be turned out in specified groups. Extra bedding and/or feeds will be provided at an additional cost agreed upon.

Horse owner is responsible for all farrier/veterinary costs. The horse owner will pay the vendor at time of service unless otherwise agreed to. Worthmore Equestrian Center provides the option of combining all charges in your monthly board bill for an administrative fee of \$10.00 per month.

All horses are required to be on a worming program. Worthmore will provide wormer for an additional cost.

Worthmore will take all reasonable care to ensure the horse remains free of injury where possible.

The horse owner will have use of space to store equipment. The horse owner is responsible for securing his/her equipment. **Horse owner will make sure all equipment is put away and facilities are clean after use.** This includes the common areas such as the wash stall, outdoor and/or indoor arenas.

Vaccinations

Before arrival of horse to Worthmore, proof of negative Coggins, current Tetanus, West Nile, Eastern/Western Encephalitis, Rabies, Strangles, Influenza, and equine herpes vaccinations are required. Vaccinations for Potomac Horse Fever and Botulism are currently optional.

Proof of Tetanus is required once yearly. A yearly Coggins is required.

Risk of Loss

During the time that the horse is in the custody of Worthmore, Worthmore **SHALL NOT** be liable for any sickness, disease, theft, death, or injury, which the horse may suffer. This includes but is not limited to any personal injury or disability the horse may receive while on premises. The horse owner fully understands and hereby acknowledges that Worthmore does not carry any insurance on any horse NOT owned by Worthmore including but not limited to, such insurance for boarding or any other purposes, for which the horse is covered under any public liability, accidental injury, theft, or equine mortality insurance, and that all risks relating to boarding of horse, or for any other reason for which the horse is in the possession of Worthmore are to be borne by the Horse Owner.

Hold Harmless

Horse owner agrees to hold Worthmore harmless from any claim resulting from damage or injury caused by said horse, owner or his/her guest and invitees, to anyone including but not limited to legal fees and/or expenses incurred by Worthmore in defense of such claims.

Stable Rules

Owner hereby acknowledges receipt and understanding of the current Stable Rules, which are attached. Owner agrees he/she and his/her guest and invitees will be bound and abide by these Rules, and accepts responsibility for the conduct of his/her guests and invitees according to these Rules.

Emergency Care

Worthmore agrees to attempt to contact horse owner at the following emergency phone number _____ should Worthmore feel that medical treatment is

needed for said horse, provided, however, in the event Worthmore is unable to so contact horse owner within a reasonable time which time shall be judged and determined solely by Worthmore, Worthmore is then hereby authorized to secure emergency veterinary care and/or farrier care and by any licensed providers of such care who are selected by Worthmore as Worthmore determines is required for the health and well-being of said horse. The cost of such care secured shall be due and payable by owner within fifteen (15) days from the date owner receives notice thereof, provided, however, that Worthmore, LLC is authorized to arrange direct billing of said care provider to the owner.

Default

Either party may terminate this agreement for failure of the other party to meet any material terms of this agreement. In the case of default by one party, the other party shall have the right to recover legal fees and expenses, if any, incurred as a result of said default. Any payment due Worthmore under this agreement shall be due and payable by the first/fifteenth of the month and immediately in the event of termination. Failure to make any payment by said due date shall place owner in default hereunder. Acceptance by Worthmore of any late payment shall not constitute waiver of subsequent due dates or determinations of default.

Assignment

Owner, without the express written consent of Worthmore, may not assign this agreement.

Notice of Termination

Owner agrees that thirty (30) days notice shall be given to Worthmore as to the termination of this agreement.

Right of Lien

Owner is put on notice that Worthmore has and may assert and exercise a right of lien for any amount due for the board and keep of horse, and also for any storage or other charges due hereunder, and further agrees Worthmore shall have the right, without process of law, to attach a lien to said horse after two (2) months of non-payment or partial payment and Worthmore can then sell horse to recover its loss.

This agreement is subject to the laws of the State of Maryland.
